At Bearwood Primary School, we have developed a real strength in the teaching of phonics. Our Phonics Screening Check results for last year's Year One was 95%. This was significantly higher than Wokingham's average of 82%, and the National average of 72%. Well done to the staff in EYFS and Year One, the parents and of course the children for all their hard work.
